This village has the Karaboro people group which the International Mission Board has listed as an unreached people group. One of the reasons this people group remains unreached is the difficulty of travel to their area. Therefore any prayers and help you can provide will be of a great blessing to help spread the Gospel to an unreached area.

There are many other ways you can continue to serve in mission locally: Visit, call, or write notes to our shut ins; write notes and send “goodies” to our college students; serve in the Good News Club; help with Duty Free or help in the Library at Eastside Elementary; read to an elementary school student; help with various needs at the Open Door ministry.

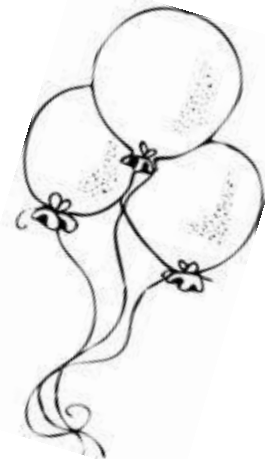
