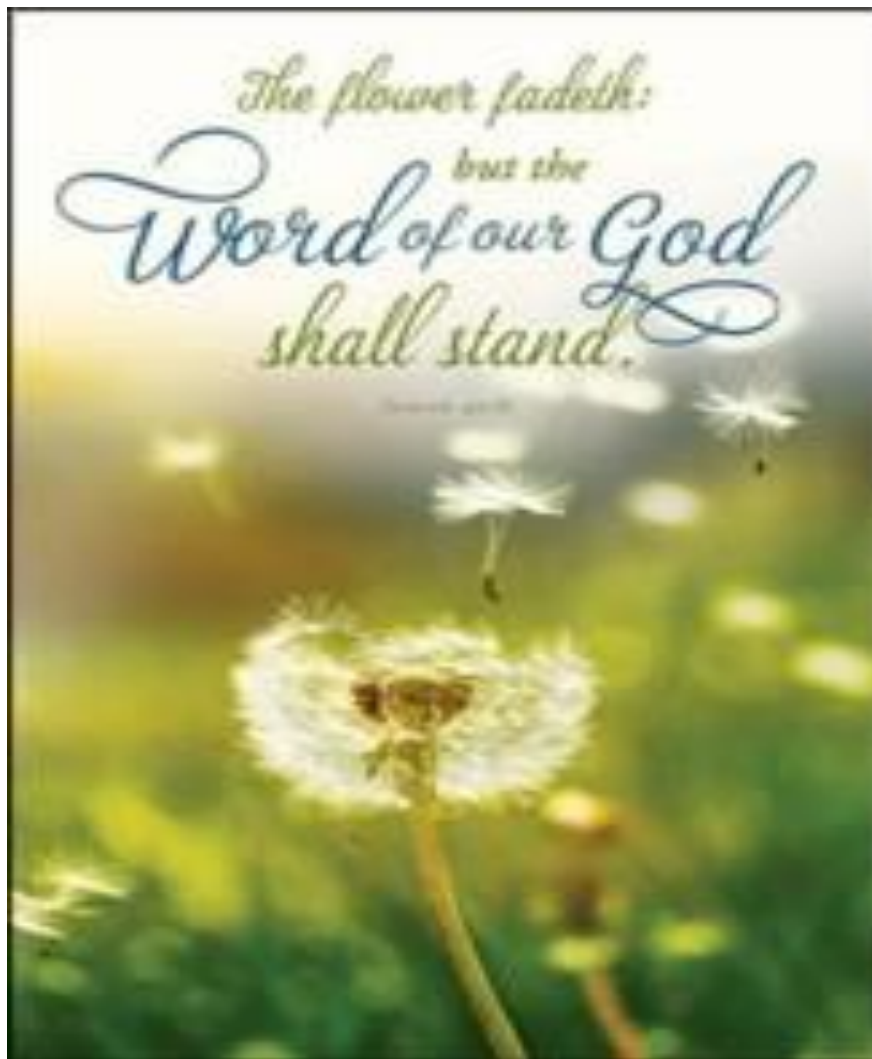

We need as many men as possible today to help cover the windows for tonight's "Art to Heart", and to help with set up. Please meet at the church at 2:00

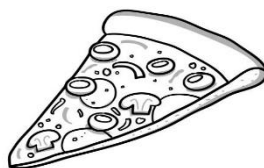
